



Scotia

Scotia is a moulded profile used for covering the perimeter gaps between a floating floor and perimeter walls or a permanent structure on the floor. It's 19mm high x 19mm deep. It is available in 2.4m lengths.



Junior end

Junior ends are used to facilitate the perimeter gap where the floor finishes along window frames, kitchen cupboards, sliding door tracks or other finished floors of the same height, like carpet or ceramic tiles. It is available in 3.4m lengths.



Multi Trim

Multi trims create a neat finish in hard-to-reach areas where maintaining perimeter expansion is required. Multi trims can be used in areas where the use of skirting or scotia is not practical, providing the required expansion gap along sliding glass doors, against fixed kitchen benches or cabinets. Multi trims are available in 3.4m lengths.



Top Cover

A top cover is a trim (strip) facilitating the required expansion where the floor ends, or joins other flooring finishes. It can also be used in areas where an expansion trim is required. A cover trim provides a neat and secure finish and is available in 3.4m lengths.



Stair Nosing

Stair nosing is a safe way to finish your flooring on the stair tread (edge) providing a bespoke matching finish.

Note:

Stair nosing is available with a slip-resistant tape if it does not meet a P3 rating.
